If you don't have checks then just print out the direct deposit form and take it to your bank and they will provide you with a bank statement to set up direct deposit. Fax or email both forms to your manager. Please remember that it takes 1-3 pay cycles for direct deposits to become effective. You can also pick up your checks at our chandler office on pay day between 9am-5pm. You must bring a picture id with you.

- Vase or clean empty can
